

University Writing Center

University Writing Center Services

Welcome back to Spring Block 1! If you have never worked with the University Writing Center before, or if you've heard of us but aren't quite sure what we do, here's a refresher. The UWC offers:

- Document review (papers, main discussion posts, case studies)
- English-as-a-second language writing assistance
- Individual chapter review of dissertations and DRPs
- Zoom appointments

Asynchronous document review: To request a review, create a new email for each submission addressed to writingcenter@atsu.edu. In the body of the email, let us know your program name and the citation style (APA or AMA) you are using. You can also provide special instructions regarding assignment type or areas of concern. If English is your second or

additional language and you would prefer a review by an ESL expert, type ATTN: ESL in the subject line of the email. Finally, attach your file (.doc or .docx only, please—we cannot review PDFs, .pages, Google Docs links, or nonstandard file types).

Hours: The UWC accepts papers from 12 AM Central Time on Mondays through 7:59 PM Central Time on Saturdays. The UWC will not review papers submitted from 8 PM Saturday through 11:59 PM Sunday, but you can resubmit when the center reopens.

Zoom appointments: The UWC offers online one-to-one sessions via Zoom to all currently enrolled ATSU students. To meet with a writing coach, go to our scheduling page, select an appointment time from the calendar, and fill in the booking form. You will receive a link to our Zoom room in a confirmation email and a reminder message two hours before your selected appointment.

Public Health Post Student Essay Contest

In an era marked by increasingly divisive rhetoric, it can feel futile to engage in difficult conversations. However, fostering dialogue—whether through civil debate, open discussion, or community-based action—remains a critical component of improving population health. In your essay, discuss why it is important to continue engaging in challenging conversations. How does this act contribute to better public health outcomes for individuals, communities, and society as a whole? Use specific examples or research to support your arguments. (800 word maximum)

To apply, fill out the questions below and upload your essay. All essays should keep a domestic focus, and all references should be embedded as hyperlinks, not as a separate bibliography. The

contest is open to 2024-25 undergraduate, masters, and doctoral students in any program of study.

The winner will receive \$250, and have their essay published in Public Health Post, after editorial review.

Public Health Post is a daily population health magazine written by public health students and practitioners, and edited by experts. Our mission is to spotlight critical intersections in public health and social justice to advance conversations about health in communities across the United States. **Enter the contest here.**
