

ATSU Student Research Fund

Apply for Funding for your Student Research Projects!

Students: ATSU is offering an exciting opportunity to fund a research project that you may be working on with a faculty mentor. Although this may be of greatest interest to students working on their ARP or DRP, any student and their mentor may apply. The ATSU Student Research Fund is a competitive grant program designed to support individual student-initiated projects under the supervision of a full-time ATSU faculty research advisor/research mentor. **The deadline to apply is October 31, 2024.** Proposals must be designed by an ATSU student in collaboration with their ATSU faculty research advisor/research mentor. The 12-month project period begins in December 2024 and ends in December 2025. We anticipate funding approximately 5 student proposals.

Kathleen Thomas, DHA, MPH

Kathleen (Kathie) Thomas, DHA, MPH currently works as the National Senior Director, Program Development, Health Science, Research & Analytics for the American Heart Association. In this position, she oversees strategic research operations, manages and directs research and measurement priorities, provides oversight and leadership, and works with thought leaders within the organization on research innovation and development of real-world evidence concepts.

Kathie has been teaching with A.T. Still University College of Graduate Health Studies for four years and has taught and developed courses related to quality improvement, performance excellence, data analytics, and interpersonal communication. She also serves on dissertation committees and serves as a doctoral research project advisor.

Kathie obtained a Bachelor of Science in Biology and a Bachelor of Science in Psychology from Michigan State University in 2009, a Master of Public Health from A.T. Still University in 2011, and a Doctorate in Health Administration from A.T. Still University in 2017. Her current research interests center around patient centered care metrics and outcomes in cardiovascular and neurological disease states.

Kathie is a regular presenter at conferences including Scientific Sessions, International Stroke Conference, Quality of Care and Outcomes Research, ACHE Congress, and Michigan Academy of Sciences, Arts, and Letters. She has published in several peer reviewed journals, such as Circulation, Circulation: Cardiovascular Quality and Outcomes, Stroke, Michigan Academician (by MASAL), Patient Experience Journal, and SAGE Research Methods Cases: Medicine and Health.

In her spare time, Kathie spends time with her family and friends and enjoys living an active lifestyle. She also serves as a foster parent, so the number of children in her home (and associated chaos) changes daily.
